### Use:


The **Red** shaded areas are the recommended locations for best microphone performance.

Items to look for before placement:

- 1. Do not place in front of air vents.
- If the vehicle has tweeters placed on sail panels, do NOT locate the mic on steering column area.
- 3. Front of mic must not be blocked.
- Mic should be firmly attached to mounting location.
- 5. Do not cover the grille openings surrounding the mic.
- To avoid excessive wind noise, do not place near the sunroof opening



Run microphone wire where it will **NOT** impede the operation of any safety items, i.e. Airbags, Knee Airbags, etc.





#### INSTALLATION

#### 1. WIRE CONNECTION




Complete all required connections so that all lines are hidden in vehicle.

#### 2. CAMERA INSTALLATION

Camera should be installed in the following configuration:

License Plate Frame Mount – Align camera frame with top-set of screw holes on license plate or license plate frame. Affix camera using license plate mount screws. See: (diagram 1)

Attention: The camera switch is controlled by reverse gear shift.



#### OPTIONAL

To remove the distance guide lines:

- 1. Turn the system OFF before proceeding
- Cut the white loop wire located at the connection points (camera end).
- 3. Insulate the wire, using tape or crimp connectors on both ends.
- 4. Reconnecting the wire will display the guide lines again.

To invert the camera image:

- 1. Turn the system OFF before proceeding
- 2. Cut the blue loop wire located at the connection points (camera end)
- 3. Insulate the wire, using tape or crimp connectors on both ends.
- 4. Reconnecting the wire will orient the image back to its original position.
